SOBA's workshops offer the opportunity to learn a variety of art skills

Each workshop will be held at the SOBA Center for Creative Arts, located next door to the SOBA Gallery at 8 Church Street in Bluffton. All SOBA workshops are led by established artists, and include instruction and hands-on demonstrations.

Basic Oil Painting Techniques

Instructor Dennis Lake

Students will learn what it takes to accomplish an oil painting and paint a picture of their choice with the techniques learned. Emphasis will be on realism with composition, color theory and paint mixing, balance, proportion and perspective. Subjects for painting should be from photo or personal sketch material. Personal and individualized critiques will enable the student to realize the potential of this beautiful medium.
