You're invited: SOBA's Holiday Boutique


November 19th - December 23rd, 2016 in the SoBA Center for Creative Arts

Inventory Check-in: Thursday, November 17th, 1:30 - 3:30pm Friday, November 18th, 9 - 11am




December at SOBA Gallery: Small Wonders A Collection of Tiny Art

The Arts Center of Coastal Carolina invites local artisans to join us for the Holly Day Art Market on Saturday, November 26.


The market is a new addition to the Arts Center and Town of Hilton Head's Official Tree Lighting Festival, which is held each year on the Saturday after Thanksgiving.
